### Campbellsville-Taylor County Economic Development Authority Minutes of Board Meeting held July 20, 2022

Members present: Mark Johnson, Barry Blevins and Jane Wheatley. Member present by video conference: David Chewning. Also, present was Ron McMahan.

Chairman Mark Johnson called the meeting to order, and Barry Blevins opened the meeting with prayer. Ron McMahan recited that the media had been properly notified of the meeting. Media notification was sent to the CKNJ, Q-104, WGRK, and 99.9 the Big Dawg.

Minutes from the June 10th, monthly meeting were reviewed. Minutes were approved by unanimous vote following motion by Jane Wheatley and seconded by Barry Blevins.

The June 2022 financials were presented by Ron McMahan. Motion made by David Chewning, seconded by Jane Wheatley to approve the June financials, passed by unanimous vote.

#### Executive Director Ron McMahan's report:

- The next board meeting is scheduled for Friday, August 12, 2022.
- EDA Board Review by Shirley Buckner will take place in August 2022.
- Taylor County's unemployment rate for was May 3.3%. Kentucky was 3.8% and the US was 3.4%.
- Workforce Development Committee –Next meeting is Tuesday, August 16, 2022.
- Project W The BUILD-Ready site, and other unimproved sites in HCTP were submitted as options for a new prospect through the KCED. They were looking for BUILD-Ready sites that could accommodate a 250,000 SF building, and possible up to 50-80 acres, depending on the topography. Site visits could take place in August 2022.
- Local Road Improvement Projects As per District 4 KY Transportation Cabinet Office, the Campbellsville Bypass from HWY 70 to 68 is expected to be completed mid 2023. The Campbellsville to Lebanon section of 68 is expected to be completed in October 2022. They will have a public meeting for HWY 210 improvements in late summer.

Ron McMahan has completed 6 RFI's (request for information) since January 2022. There was a site visit on 3/11 and 3/16 from two prospects interested in the BUILD-Ready site in HCTP.

- KY PDI Grant A lengthy discussion on the upcoming 2022 Product
   Development Initiative matching grant for economic development purposes
   took place. Eligible options for submission were reviewed. Further discussion
   will talk place.
- Warehouse/Distribution buildings Five inquires for available options in Taylor County were made in the last 45 days. Ron McMahan referred them to possible options. Apparently, they could not find any available space.
- Recycling Center No update on the county's recycling center project this month.
- Motion to adjourn was made by David Chewning, seconded by Jane Wheatley and approved by unanimous vote.
