Campbellsville-Taylor County Economic Development Authority Minutes of Board Meeting held October 13, 2023

Members present: Mark Johnson, Barry Blevins and John Chowning. Members present by Zoom: Angie Call and David Chewning. Also, present was Ron McMahan.

Chairman Mark Johnson called the meeting to order, and John Chowning opened the meeting with prayer. Ron McMahan recited that the media had been properly notified of the meeting. Media notification was sent to the CKNJ, Q-104, WGRK, and 99.9 the Big Dawg.

Minutes from the September 2023, monthly meeting were reviewed. Minutes were approved by unanimous vote following motion by Barry Blevins and seconded by David Chewning.

The September 2023 financials were presented by Ron McMahan. Motion made by John Chowning, seconded by Angie Call to approve the September financials, passed by unanimous vote.

Executive Director Ron McMahan's report:

- The next board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 14, 2023.
- Taylor County's unemployment rate for 8/23 was 4.0% Kentucky was 4.3% and the US was 3.9%.
- Project T A site visit was made on 10/11/23 by two site selection consultants working for an international auto manufacturing supplier, to HCTP's 27.5-acre BUILD-Ready site. The capital investment is \$30 million, with 100 jobs. The building would be 200,000 sqft.
- Project M A RIF was completed and submitted to the Cabinet for Economic Development, for a large food production and distribution facility. The capital investment is \$75 million, with 273 jobs, a 150,000 sqft building needing at least 50 acres.
- INFAC A landscaping replacement plans was discussed along KY 55. It was suggested I contact TCRECC for their approval of what if any landscaping can be replaced so close to their transmission line easement.
- HCTP Substation Project I signed the easement documents for the utility line from the substation to INCAC.

- HCTP With the need for additional infrastructured, industrial land, creating an additional 20+ acre site within HCTP was discussed. Ron is to research how much land might be developable for the November meeting.
- Wise Buckner and Sprowles will be presenting the annual FY2022-2023 EDA board review audit in December.
- Motion made to adjourn was made by David Chewning, seconded by Angie Call, and approved by unanimous vote.
