### Campbellsville-Taylor County Economic Development Authority Minutes of Board Meeting held March 15, 2024

Members present: Barry Blevins, and Jane Wheatley. Members present by Zoom: Mark Johnson, Angie Call, David Chewning, and John Chowning. Also present was Ron McMahan, Isaac South and Michelle Gaines.

Chairman Mark Johnson called the meeting to order, and Jane Wheatley opened the meeting with prayer. Ron McMahan recited that the media had been properly notified of the meeting. Media notification was sent to the CKNJ, Q-104, WGRK, and 99.9 the Big Dawg.

Minutes from the February 23rd monthly meeting were reviewed. Minutes were approved by unanimous vote following motion by Barry Blevins and seconded by John Chowning.

The February 2024 financials were presented by Ron McMahan. Motion made by David Chewning, seconded by Jane Wheatley to approve the February financials, passed by unanimous vote.

#### Executive Director Ron McMahan's report:

- The next board meeting is scheduled for Friday, April 12, 2024.
- Taylor County's unemployment rate for 1/24 was 4.4%, Kentucky was 4.8% and the US was 4.1%.
- EDA BOD Terms Discussion by the board took place on two board terms that expire 6/30/2024 that are up for reappointment. Motion made by David Chewning, seconded by John Chowning to recommend the reappointment of Jane Wheatley for a four-year city term appointment and Barry Blevins as a four-year county term appointment, passed by a unanimous vote. Ron McMahan is to send letters of request from the EDA Board of Directors to Mayor Benningfield and Judge/Executive Smith.
- EDA Occupancy Payment to the City Discussion by the board took place on the request for the EDA to sign a new MOU on paying \$200 per month occupancy expenses for the Civic Center office. Motion made by Angie Call, seconded by John Chowning to amend the FY 2023-24 budget to reflect payment beginning on 22 March 2024, passed by a unanimous vote.

- HCTP Discussion took place by the board on potentially creating an
  additional 30-to-40-acre available industrial lot in the wooded area of HCTP.
  Motion made by John Chowning, seconded by Barry Blevins to have Palmer
  Engineering submit a scope of work proposal for review on conducting the
  necessary due diligence studies to determine if this is feasible, passed by
  unanimous vote.
- Kentucky PDI 2024 (Product Development Initiative) Discussion took place
  on the possible projects to submit for the state matching funds if approved by
  the General Assembly this session. Possible projects could include, site work,
  a 200,000 SF expandable BUILD-Ready pad site, additional land purchase and
  a speculative building.
- Area Development Louisville Consultants Forum Ron McMahan will attend the site selection consultant's forum March 18-20.
- Site Selectors Guild Nashville Meeting Ron McMahan will attend the site selection consultant's meeting April 3-5.
- KAED (Kentucky Association for Economic Development) Spring Conference Somerset Ron McMahan will attend the KAED conference April 23-25.
- Existing Business Project An existing business is proposing a possible expansion project for 2024, pending corporate approval. Ron McMahan provided information about state tax incentive programs. More information will be available in the coming weeks.
- Project GCT No update. Project is still on hold.
- Project T No update. Project is still on hold.
- Project D Tech No update. The project is still on hold.
- Project R No update. The project is still on hold.
- Motion made to adjourn was made by Angie Call, seconded by John Chowning, and approved by unanimous vote.
