Campbellsville-Taylor County Economic Development Authority Minutes of Board Meeting held July 11, 2025

Members present: Mark Johnson, Jane Wheatley, John Chowning, Barry Blevins, and Jeff Williams. Member present by Zoom: David Chewning. Also present was Ron McMahan.

Chairman Mark Johnson called the meeting to order, and John Chowning opened the meeting with prayer. Ron McMahan recited that the media had been properly notified of the meeting. Media notification was sent to the CKNJ, Q-104, WGRK, and 99.9 the Big Dawg.

Minutes from the June 13th monthly meeting were reviewed. Minutes were approved by unanimous vote following motion by Barry Blevins and seconded by John Chowning.

The June financials were presented by Ron McMahan. Motion made by John Chowning, seconded by David Chewning to approve the June financials, passed by unanimous vote.

Motion made by Mark Johnson, seconded by Barry Blevins, to nominate David Chewning as Vice Chairperson for a one-year term, passed by unanimous vote.

Executive Director Ron McMahan's report:

- The next board meeting is scheduled for Friday, August 8, 2025.
- May 2025 unemployment rate for Taylor County was 4.8%, KY 4.4%, and US 4.0%.
- Kentucky PDI 2024 (Product Development Initiative) Ron McMahan has a call
 with Palmer Engineering next week to begin the process to get the project
 ready to go to bid.
- Project Dyna No update this month as per KCED project manager. A HCTP site visit was made by the prospective company representatives on June 11th.
 They were visiting three counties in KY.
- Existing Business Expansion Project A local existing business will be on the
 July 31st KEDFA agenda seeking review and approval of their application for
 state tax incentives. They will create 35 new jobs and have \$635,000 in capital
 investment for new equipment.

- Project Bev No update available this month.
- Project Wolf As per KCED project manager, they eliminated Taylor County because the available, existing building was not what they needed.
- Project Leonardo As per KCED project manager, they eliminated Kentucky because the buildings were not what they needed.
- Project Kranken As per KCED project manager, their consultant stated the project is on hold over the current economic and political climate.
- Project P KCED has not heard back from their consultant with an update.
- Project Yogi As per KCED project manager, the sites data and information is in the client's hands, and deliberations are underway.
- Project D Several due-diligence studies are still ongoing. The project plans to go before the KEDFA board in July or August for review of state tax incentives.
- Project BTR As per KCED project manager, their consultant said it's unlikely the project will ramp back up.
- Project Gen Dry As per KCED project manager, they have eliminated Kentucky.
- Ron McMahan will be attended the Site Selectors Guild Forum in Santa Fe June 25-26, where 8 SSG consultants were in attendance. McMahan will be attending their Fall meeting in Indianapolis in October.
- Motion made by John Chowning, seconded by Barry Blevins to go into executive session to discuss Project D, passed by unanimous vote.
- Motion made by Jane Wheatley, seconded by John Chowning to return to regular session, passed by unanimous vote. No action taken.
- Motion made to adjourn was made by Barry Blevins, seconded by John Chowning, and approved by unanimous vote.
